

### 2019 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

<u>Statement of purpose</u>: The Allendale Rotary Club has established a scholarship program. Our goal is to assist Allendale residents who are high school seniors, who have been accepted and will be attending a Michigan college in the fall immediately following their high school graduation.

<u>Qualification</u>: All candidates are judged on their merit. Primary consideration is given to individuals who have demonstrated leadership, citizenship, volunteerism and involvement in school and/or community activities. There must be evidence of a strong desire to succeed.

<u>Giving of the Scholarship Awards</u>: A committee, comprised of Allendale Rotary Club members, will select the recipient(s) of the \$1,000.00 award. The recipient(s) will be invited to attend the Allendale Public School's annual honors ceremony in May to receive their scholarship award. Upon acceptance of the Scholarship Award, recipient (s) agree to give 10 hours of volunteer time to this local Rotary Club as a way to become involved in Rotary and give back to the community for this support.

### **Application Requirements:**

- A student information profile.
- An essay on the Rotary's motto, which is "Service Above Self". What does this mean to you?
- A copy of the student's transcript.
- Two letters of personal recommendation.
- A letter of acceptance to a Michigan college or university for Fall 2018.

#### **Procedures and Guidelines:**

- Each school will publicize scholarship announcement and availability.
- Applicants are responsible for timely completion of all requirements.
- Incomplete applications or applications submitted after the deadline of April 14, 2019, will be disqualified.

### ROTARY INFORMATION

Rotary began as an idea more than 100 years ago. Today, Rotary flourishes worldwide with 1.2 million members in more than 200 countries and geographic areas. The world's first club, the Rotary Club of Chicago, was formed in 1905 by Paul P. Harris, an attorney who wished to capture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The Rotary name is derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among member's offices.

Rotary popularity spread, and within decades, clubs were chartered from San Francisco to New York to Winnipeg, Canada. By 1921, Rotary clubs had been formed on six continents.

The Allendale Rotary Club was established on March 5, 2009. The club currently has 14 members.

### OUR COMMITTMENT TO ALLENDALE

Since its inception in 2009, the Allendale Rotary Club has supported initiatives within the Allendale Community to better serve our children and families. The Club annually raises funds for the Amazing Reading Bus which provides literacy opportunities to children through out the community. Allendale Rotary Funds have also gone to support the Splash pad in the Allendale Park as well as the Back to School Fair and various local non-profit groups.

The Rotary Club has sent several students to an annual Life Leadership Conference to develop leadership skills and continues to focus on the importance of continuing education by providing scholarships each year.

It is our hope that our service to Allendale will make a positive impact for generations to come and will inspire others to service as well.
